New Updates:

Dominic Yagong updated the council on the upcoming 130<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration scheduled for July 19 and 20, 2019. Lots of support and help is needed for this event. Listed below are a few updates thus far.

- Finances: The committee has received \$23,005 as of this date. Additional donations are expected.
- Block party: The road will be closed from Ikeuchi Store to The Salvation Army between 5:00 to 9:00 p.m. on Friday, July 19. There will be four stages set up featuring various music bands. A few sites along the town will be set up for various demonstrations such as ariel silk dancing and cirque ohana. The school stage will be loaned for the block party. Custodians will set it by

the credit union up by 3:30 p.m. on Friday, July 19. Volunteers are needed for disassembly the next day.

- Parade: The parade is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 20. The staging areas for the floats will be at the Hongwanji, NHERC, the county gym and the Catholic Church. There will be no traffic allowed through the school area.
- Festival: The festival will begin at noon at the school field. Details of the various events are attached.
- Security: There will be security on site during the entire event.
- Event clean up: A committee will be formed to pick up and remove remaining trash from the field on Sunday, July 21.

#### Action list for School administration:

- Rachelle will try to get a list of the past Principals for the event committee. The committee would like to send a letter to them requesting their attendance as grand marshals'.
- School administrators will organize a group of volunteers to man a school store booth and donation tent.
- A "walk through the hallway" tour of A building and the auditorium will be scheduled for alumni.
- Rachelle to secure elementary school parking (behind the cafeteria) for handicapped alumni who are attending the festival.
- School staff will build the letters *HHIS 130* which will be ignited at the Festival.
- Vendor applications are available at the school

- Students will be asking each grade if they are interested in making a float or having a marching unit for the parade.
