CONGRESSIONAL ART COMPETITION

The Congressional Art Competition is an annual event sponsored by the U.S. House of Representatives that **recognizes and encourages high school students nationwide to demonstrate their artistic talent**.

KEY DEADLINES

March 2024 – The Congressional Art Competition will officially open and our office will begin accepting art submissions. To submit, visit bit.ly/tokudaartcontest.

April 15, 2024 – Students must submit a photo of the completed art piece and release form via email by **5:00 pm HST.**

April 19, 2024 – DEADLINE: The <u>original</u> completed art piece must be submitted to our district office via mail, delivery service, or in person by **5:00 pm HST.**

May 2024 – Winners will be notified and publicly announced. An award ceremony will be held in Hawaii and a ceremony in Washington, D.C. will be held on June 27, 2024.

MILITARY SERVICE ACADEMY NOMINATIONS

The Military Service Academy Nominations are **an opportunity for individuals to be considered by a Service Academy to attend one of four world-class institutions at no expense to the student.** Congresswoman Jill Tokuda may nominate up to ten individuals for each vacant academy slot allotted to the Second Congressional District. **The four U.S. Service Academies are**: U.S. Military Academy, West Point, NY; U.S. Naval Academy, Annapolis, MD; U.S. Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, CO; and U.S. Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point, NY.

KEY DEADLINES

June 2024 – Application portal opens.

October 2024 - DEADLINE: Completed applications are due.

November 2024 - Applicants will be interviewed.

December 2024 – Applicants will be informed of the outcome and nominees will be announced.

CONGRESSIONAL APP CHALLENGE

The Congressional App Challenge is an annual coding competition that **encourages** middle and high school students nationwide to showcase their creativity in the fields of computer science, coding, and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) by creating a software application, or "app," for mobile, tablet, or computer devices.

KEY DEADLINES

February 2024 – Pre-registration begins.

May 1, 2024 – The Congressional App Challenge Opens.

October 24, 2024 - DEADLINE: Student applications are due.

December 2024 – Winner(s) will be notified and announced by Rep. Tokuda's office.

December 2024 – Winner(s) will be publicly announced by the Congressional App Challenge organizers.
